Internal regulations for students

- 1. Students are obliged to participate in all lectures, seminars and exercises.
- 2. Three absences from classes are allowed during the academic year.
- 3. A student who is absent from more than 3 classes must take an additional intermediate exam to be eligible for the final exam.
- 3. At the seminars students should have a basic knowledge on the seminar topics (based on lectures and textbooks).
- 4. Seminars start with a short entrance test consisting of 5 multiple choice questions related to the seminar's topic.
- 5. A student who is late for a seminar will obtain zero points from the entrance test.
- 6. A student must score at least 50% plus 1 point to be eligible for the intermediate exam (an average from all seminars in a thematic block). Students who do not meet this criterion will be given an unsatisfactory mark for the intermediate and will have to take the retake exam.
- 7. Students may retake each intermediate exam twice.
- 8. A student has to pass all the intermediate exams to become eligible for the final exam.
- 9. The course ends with the final exam in the (MCQ) format. Intermediate exams and retakes may be oral or written or both.
